

Millennia Atlantic University Emilia Tirado Scholarship for Starting Undergraduate Students Application Form (STS127)



The Emilia Tirado Scholarship is a partial scholarship based on merit for first-time undergraduate students. This scholarship is available for qualifying undergraduate students who are starting a degree program at MAU. This scholarship provides a financial award of forty percent (40%) payment made towards the tuition costs for each semester. For students receiving financial aid, the calculation of the financial award of forty percent (40%) towards tuition costs for each semester applies only to the remaining tuition balance after financial aid and other assistance are taken into account.

To qualify you must:

1. Complete a MAU Scholarship Application Form.
2. Be a full-time student during the spring and fall semester maintaining a course load of 12 to 15 semester credit hours at the undergraduate level. This restriction does not apply if you are starting a degree program during one of the summer semesters or at the mid-term start point.
3. Have completed high school with a minimum CGPA of 2.9, or an associate degree with a minimum CGPA of 2.9. To establish this, you must arrange for the delivery of original or certified sealed copies of all applicable transcripts to MAU. If your degree is from an institution outside the U.S., the transcripts must be submitted along with an official credential evaluation by a recognized evaluation service. All such evidence must be accompanied by a certified translation into English if the documents were originally created in a language other than English.
4. Provide two (2) letters of recommendation from former high school or other postsecondary institution faculty members, advisors or employers. The letter(s) cannot be from someone related to you.
5. Write and submit an essay with a minimum of 300 words (maximum of 800 words), which explains why MAU should grant the scholarship.

 - 3. An autobiographical essay containing a minimum of 300 words (max of 800), which explains: why MAU should grant you a scholarship.*
