Millennial Scholarship for Master's Level Latin American and Caribbean Students

Application Form (STS118)



Millennia Atlantic University offers limited merit based partial scholarships on a semester basis, to qualified master's level students who are residents of Latin America and the Caribbean countries. This scholarship provides a financial award of fifty percent (50%) of the tuition costs for each semester. For students receiving financial aid or other tuition assistance, the financial award calculation of the fifty percent (50%) payment towards tuition costs is only applied to the remaining tuition balance after financial aid and other programs are applied.

To qualify student must:

1. Complete MAU Scholarship Application Form.
2. Provide proof of residency from his or her country of origin within Latin America or the Caribbean through the presentation of an official unexpired passport from the appropriate authorities of the issuing country.
3. Be an international student holding a current F-1 Visa with MAU.
4. Establish that he or she has completed a bachelor's degree or the equivalent with a CGPA minimum of 3.1 from a postsecondary institution. This can be proved through the delivery of an original or certified sealed copy of an academic transcript from the issuing college or university, and an official credential evaluation completed and submitted to Millennia Atlantic University by a recognized evaluation service. All such evidence must be accompanied by a certified translation into English if the documents were originally created in a language other than English.
5. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation:
 - One (1) from a previous employer/supervisor or business associate.
 - One (1) from a faculty member or advisor.
6. Write and submit an essay containing a minimum of 800 words (maximum of 1000 words) on one (1) of the following topics:
 - An autobiographical essay which details previous education, employment experience, and future professional goals.
 - An essay that discusses, "What matters most to you, and why?" or, "What do you want to do with an MBA from MAU?"

For documents issued in another country other than the U.S., a credential evaluation should be provided by a recognized evaluation service. All such evidence must be accompanied by a copy of the certified translation into English if the documents were originally created in a language other than English.

- 4. Two (2) letters of recommendation. One letter should be from a postsecondary institution faculty member or advisor, and the second letter should be from an employer, supervisor or business associate.*
- 5. An autobiographical essay which details previous education, employment experience, and future professional goals; or, one that discusses your definition of a successful career, what matters most in your educational program and which describes with detail plans for your graduate degree from the University. This essay must contain a minimum of 800 words (max of 1000). Remember to sign your essay.*
